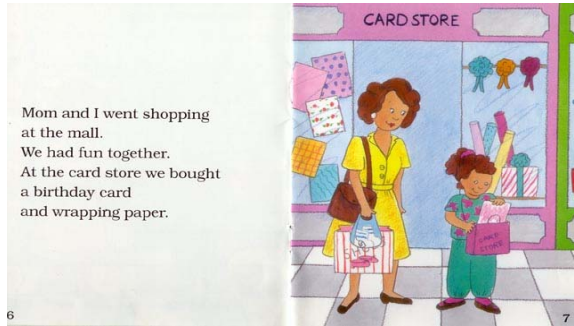

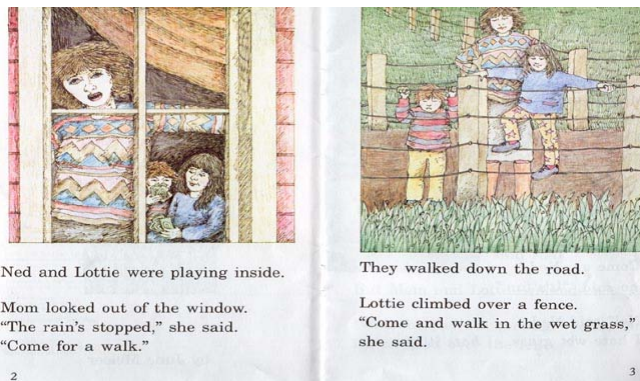
Mom and I went shopping
