TIPS TO SUPPORT YOUR READER

As your child reads Fiction texts, ask:

- Who are the main characters?
- How have the characters changed during the book?
- What questions do you have as you are reading?
- Is the story written in first or third person point of view?
- What is the author's purpose? Persuade, Inform, Entertain?
- What do you predict will happen next?
- What lesson did the characters learn?
- What was your favorite part and why?
- Did you like the ending? If not, how would you change it?


