INSTEAD OF SAYING	TRY
What is it?	Tell me about your artwork! (Ask for kids to elaborate about their details instead of assuming their art has to "be" something.)
it's so neat!	Your repeating lines/patterns really catch my eyel (Be specific with your comments)
That's a cool ideal	How did you do that? (Engage in a conversation with further questioning)
Put it on the fridge!	What would you like to do with your art? Do you want to give it to someone? Should we display it? (Give students choice and ownership over what to do with their creation)
I love it!	How do you feel about it? Are you a proud artist? (Instead of giving immediate affirmation, ask the kid to identify their feelings about their artwork first)

Positively Awesome PE By Coach Westphal

Please remember to have PE shoes.

All kindergarteners are encouraged to learn how to tie shoes at home. We will be having a class challenge in January to see which class has the most students who can tie shoes.

K-2 graders have been spending time in PE working on Manipulative skills. Manipulative skills involve challenges with bean bags, scarves, hula hoops, balls and foam noodles. These type of challenges work on agility, balance, coordination and reaction time. There are lots of cool tricks your child can show you! Ask your child about "Phys Ed School."

3-5 graders have been working on playground games like rally ball, 2-square & 4-square. Ask your child what all these games have in common. Ask your child what it means to keep a rally score and what is the definition of a "fault" in one of these games.

3-5 graders will also begin working on learning the 5 <u>Health-Related</u> Components of Fitness. These are cardiorespiratory endurance, muscle strength & endurance, flexibility and body composition.
